

Suggestions for Ladies Lunch Bunch Leaders



You have volunteered to be a Lunch Bunch Leader. Thank You!

- ❖ *At the rotation luncheon, you and your luncheon group will settle on a date, time and restaurant for your next luncheon. See the suggested restaurant list if needed. Luncheons usually occur once a month.*
- ❖ *A few days following the rotation, you should confirm this information by email or phone with your group. Remember that some ladies in your group were unable to attend the rotation luncheon and will be waiting to hear from you. So that everyone will get to know each other, it is suggested that you provide everyone in your group with a copy of the group list. This can be scanned and emailed to everyone or copied.*
- ❖ *Your email should request an RSVP. The email should also include what time and where you will meet for carpooling. The custom in Stone Creek is that we meet in the back of the parking lot of the Reunion Center. Some ladies may wish to car pool and others may prefer to meet everyone at the restaurant. Ask for volunteers to drive if needed. If someone RSVP'd that they were coming and don't show up at the parking lot, wait a few minutes and then leave. Sometimes emergencies come up and someone may not show up.*
- ❖ *Always confirm all pertinent information a few days before your lunch date. This also will serve as a reminder to everyone. Also, call the restaurant to make reservations in advance. Note too that some restaurants are closed on Mondays.*
- ❖ *At your lunch, you will, as a group, determine your next month's luncheon day and location. A good idea is to choose a different day each month so that most ladies will be able to attend most luncheons. We all have busy schedules here at Stone Creek!*
- ❖ *Please note that our club keeps official group and member lists and I need to keep them up to date. Member lists are required to be turned in to the Lifestyle Office. **Do not make any changes to your group on your own.** I may contact you as new members join our club, and I will ask you to add them to your group list.*
- ❖ *Enjoy your luncheons, and I hope you make many lasting friendships! Contact me if you have any questions.*

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Frequently Asked Questions

1. *I (or one of the other ladies) have a friend visiting from out of town. Can they attend the luncheon? **Of course. The friend should alert the leader that a friend is coming along.***
2. *I met someone new in the neighborhood who is interested in joining the Lunch Bunch. What should I do? **They should contact Barbara Iazzetti or one of the other officers. When they pay their dues, they will be placed in a group that can accommodate another member and they will be added to the official member list.***
3. *I am the leader but can't plan the next luncheon because I'll be out of town. What should I do? **Ask one of the ladies in your group to cover for you. Make sure they know what the procedure is.***
4. *I will be out of town for the next rotation luncheon. Can I still be in the Lunch Bunch? **Yes. Let one of the officers know that you will be out of town. They will be sure that your name is added to a group. If you are not presently a member, your dues will need to be paid first.***
5. *There are only a few ladies able to go to lunch this month. Should I cancel the lunch? **Of course not. This is a great opportunity to have a more personal conversation in a small group setting. One of these ladies might turn out to be a very good friend to you!***

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
