Intermediate Mountain Biking: There is a group that rides at least twice a month, usually on Tuesday or Thursday mornings. Typically 10-20 miles, singletrack, expect to go over and around roots, rocks, gravel, boulders, sharp turns, short steep descents and inclines (but no jumps), wooden features.
